

Method for designating cable tray tees

Cable tray tees are installed by aligning the branch tray at the desired angle, securing it with compatible fittings, and ensuring proper support and grounding according to IEC 61537 and NEMA VE 2 standards. Tee Installation Overview A cable tray tee is used to branch a main cable tray run into two directions, forming a “T” junction. The standard method involves:

- Grounding and bonding:** Ensure the tee and all connected trays are properly grounded to prevent electrical hazards. Use bonding jumpers if required by local electrical codes.
- Cable management:** Maintain proper cable spacing and bend radius at the tee. Avoid sharp bends or overcrowding, which can damage insulation or reduce airflow in ventilated trays.
