

Methods for fixing stepped cable trays

1. Use of Threaded Rods and Suspended Supports For trays that change height or step up/down, threaded rods can suspend the tray from ceilings or overhead structures. Rods should be fixed with appropriate metal plugs and nuts, ensuring a maximum spacing of around 1.2 meters between supports to prevent sagging. This method allows precise height adjustment and keeps cables accessible for maintenance.
2. Wall-Mounted or Ceiling Brackets Where ceiling suspension is not feasible, wall-mounted brackets or ceiling-mounted supports can secure trays at stepped levels. Brackets should be strong enough to handle the combined weight of the tray and cables, and adjustable brackets can accommodate minor height variations.
3. Use of 'L' Angles or Slotted 'C' Channels At step points, 'L' angles or slotted 'C' channels can be installed to provide additional support and maintain alignment. These fittings help manage offsets and bends while preventing cable damage during installation.
4. Proper Cutting and Joining Cable trays should be cut to the required length using appropriate tools. At stepped sections, ensure smooth edges and use mushroom head screws or other protective fasteners to avoid damaging cable insulation during pulling.
5. Maintaining Clearance and Alignment Mark the tray routes according to approved shop drawings, ensuring horizontal and vertical runs are coordinated with other services. Maintain sufficient clearance for cable pulling and future maintenance. Supports should be placed at bends, branches, and offsets to prevent deflection and maintain structural integrity.
6. Inspection and Compliance All materials and supports should be inspected before installation to ensure they meet project specifications. Only use components designed and tested together as a system to c...
