

Optical Module Fiber Optic Patch Cord Connector

Fiber optic patch cords connect optical modules to network devices, and proper matching of connector type, fiber type, and endface polish is essential for optimal network performance. A fiber optic patch cord (also called a fiber jumper) is a pre-terminated fiber cable used to connect two optical devices, such as transceivers, switches, patch panels, or ONTs, enabling optical signal transmission. Patch cords come in single-mode (OS1/OS2, G.657A1/A2) for long-distance or FTTH applications, and multimode (OM1, OM2, OM3, OM4, OM5) for shorter distances and high-speed data centers. They can be simplex (one fiber, one-way) or duplex (two fibers, two-way), with duplex being standard for Ethernet and PON links.

Connector Types Common fiber optic connectors include:

- LC (Lucent Connector):** Small form factor, high density, preferred in modern switches and data centers.
- SC (Subscriber Connector):** Larger, easy to handle, common in FTTH and CATV.
- FC (Ferrule Connector) and ST (Straight Tip):** Used in legacy or industrial applications.
- MPO/MTP:** Multi-fiber connectors for high-speed 40G/100G networks, enabling parallel transmission.

Connector choice must match the optical module interface or use adapters to bridge mismatched types.

Endface Types The endface polish affects signal quality and reflection:

- PC (Physical Contact):** Standard, cost-effective, micro-spherical polish.
- UPC (Ultra Physical Contact):** Optimized PC with lower insertion loss, suitable for most standard applications.
- APC (Angled Physical Contact):** Polished at an 8-degree angle to minimize back reflection, ideal for long-distance, high-speed, or reflection-sensitive applications.

Optical modules typically require PC or UPC patch cords, while APC is used for specialized high-performance links.
