Use the ANSI/NETA ATS-2025 as a guide to ensure that electrical systems and apparatus not only meet project specifications, but that the manufacturer of the equipment supplied a product that will perform safely and reliably for many years to come. This section includes the specifications for constructing and building out of Telecommunications Equipment Rooms (MDF/IDFs) to be used for supporting telecommunications and other special systems. The telecommunications space is an enclosed architectural space for housing communications cabling, cable terminations, and cross-connect hardware and telecommunications electronics. 1382 aims to drive future-oriented network deployment for the information and communication technology (ICT) industry, as well as. 5" deep by.
