Main Distribution Box Role The main distribution box, also called a distribution board or panel, serves as the central hub of an electrical system. It receives incoming power from the main supply and distributes it to multiple branch circuits, including both lighting and power outlets. It houses protective devices like breakers and residual current devices to ensure safety and organized power distribution. Because it handles the primary incoming supply and often supports high-capacity loads, it is classified as a power distribution box rather than a lighting distribution box.

Safety and Operation Due to the higher voltage and current levels, main distribution boxes require careful handling. Only qualified personnel should operate or maintain them. Proper installation, grounding, and protective devices are essential to prevent overloads, short circuits, and electrical hazards.
