For example, a pass-through switch receiving 30W from a PoE injector may use 5W for itself and provide 25W to connected devices. Requirements and Considerations The upstream PoE source must supply sufficient power to meet the switch's operational needs and the power requirements of connected devices. PoE standards vary: PoE (IEEE 802.3af) provides up to 15.4W per port, PoE+ (IEEE 802.3at) up to 30W, and PoE++ (IEEE 802.3bt) up to 60–100W per port. Not all switches support PoE input; it is essential to verify that the switch is designed for PoE-powered operation. The total power budget of the switch and the number of PoE ports determine how much power can be delivered to downstream devices. Practical Use Cases PoE-powered switches are particularly useful in locations where AC power outlets are limited or difficult to install, such as ceilings, outdoor areas, or remote network points. They simplify installation by reducing cabling and allow flexible placement of network devices.
