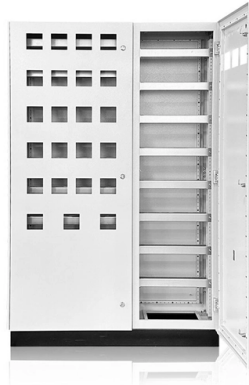

Intumescent linings expand in the event of a fire, creating a seal that slows the spread of flames and smoke, giving occupants time to evacuate and fire services time to respond. This is particularly important for consumer units susceptible to overloading. Safe Covering and Accessibility Any cover or enclosure must allow immediate and full access to the panel and circuit breakers without tools. The working clearance around the panel should be at least 30 inches wide and 36 inches deep, with a vertical clearance of 6.5 feet, ensuring safe operation and maintenance.
