

Requirements for laying optical cables in the workshop

Preparation and Workspace Setup Before laying optical cables, ensure the workshop is clean, free of sharp objects, and has adequate space for cable handling and storage. Installation Techniques Use cable grips and swivels to prevent twisting and ensure pulling tension does not exceed the maximum specified by the manufacturer. Maintain smooth curvatures and avoid sharp changes in direction. For LSZH or sensitive sheathed cables, minimize mechanical stress and avoid high temperatures during installation. Ensure proper racking in trays or conduits without pinching the cable against edges.

Supervision and Quality Control Supervise cable reception, handling, and laying to ensure compliance with specifications. Document cable sections, splices, and protective elements, and verify that all installation steps are performed correctly. Conduct post-installation checks to confirm cable integrity...
