

Router and Fiber Optic Cable Interfaces

Fiber optic cables connect to routers indirectly via an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) or directly through SFP/SFP+ ports on fiber-ready routers.

Key Components for Fiber Connection

- Link ONT to Router:** Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN port to the router's WAN port. For routers with SFP/SFP+ slots, you can insert a compatible fiber module to connect directly to the fiber cable.
- Router Configuration:** Power on the router and access its configuration interface (usually via 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1) to ensure proper network settings. Enable Quality of Service (QoS) if needed for VoIP or video streaming.
- Fiber Interfaces on Routers**
 - WAN/Ethernet Port:** Standard interface for connecting the router to the ONT.
 - SFP/SFP+ Port:** Allows direct fiber connection for high-speed or multi-gigabit setups, bypassing the ONT in some advanced configurations.
- Compatibility Check:** Ensure the router supports the fiber speed provided by your ISP (e.g., gigabit or 10 Gbps) to fully utilize the fiber connection.

Best Practices

- Keep the ONT close to the fiber entry point to minimize signal loss.
- Handle fiber connectors carefully; dust or misalignment can degrade performance.
- Use high-quality Ethernet cables (Cat6a or higher) between the ONT and router to...
