Power Cycle and Reset Reboot Devices: Turn off the router and modem, wait 30 seconds, then power them back on. Reset Router: If rebooting fails, perform a factory reset using the reset button, then reconfigure with ISP credentials (Savanna Fibre). Check for ISP Issues Sometimes the problem is external. Confirm with your ISP whether there is a local service outage or maintenance affecting your fiber connection (Brightspeed). Preventive Tips Handle fiber cables carefully to avoid bending or stretching. Keep connectors clean using proper fiber cleaning tools. Ensure the router firmware is up to date.
