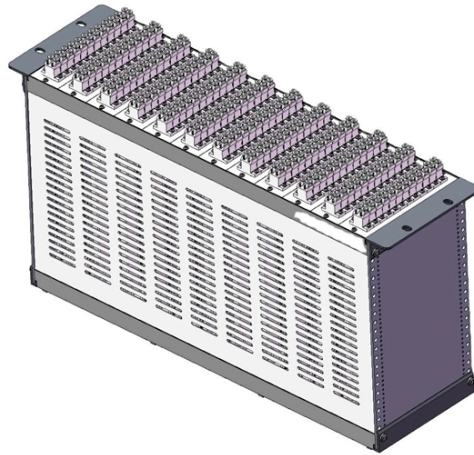


Spacing of outdoor fireproof cable trays



Overview

When installing two cable trays in parallel at the same height, the distance between them should be no less than 0. This spacing is crucial for adequate maintenance access, ease of inspection, and ensuring proper airflow for effective heat dissipation. Cable tray installation must comply with specific technical standards to ensure electrical safety, system reliability, and long-term maintainability. The spacing between trays, whether horizontal or vertical, depends on various factors like cable type, environment, and tray material.
