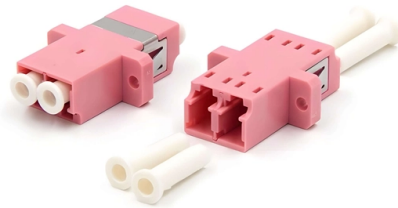


Switch fiber optic ports A and B



AI Overview

Fiber optic A/B switches allow you to select between two fiber paths (A or B) for a single device, either manually or via remote control, while maintaining signal integrity.

Overview of Fiber Optic A/B Switches

A fiber optic A/B switch is a device that connects a single network device or fiber link (COMMON port) to one of two other fiber paths (A or B ports). These switches are transparent to data, meaning they do not alter the signal and can handle high-speed data such as Gigabit Ethernet. They are commonly used in applications where redundancy or alternate routing is required, such as in government, healthcare, or financial networks.

Port Configuration

COMMON Port: Connects to the device or network segment that will switch between paths.

A and B Ports: Connect to the two fiber optic networks or devices you want to select between.

Connector Type: Typically SC Duplex, Single Mode (9/125 micron) or Multimode, depending on the switch model.

Wavelength Support: Many switches support 1300nm for single-mode fiber. The fiber ports are configured according to TIA/EIA-568-B.3 standards, ensuring that the TX of the COMMON port is routed to the RX of the selected A or B port and vice versa.

Switching Methods

Manual Switching: Most switches have a front panel pushbutton to toggle between A and B ports. LEDs indicate the current switch position and power status.

Remote Control:

- RS-232 ASCII Commands:** Allows you to switch ports, lockout front panel operations, and query switch status via a serial connection.
- Contact Closure:** Uses dry contact logic to control the switch position remotely, suitable for integration with automation systems.
- MEMS-Based Switching:** Many modern switches use break-before-make MEMS mirrors or prisms to ensure that the signal is not interrupted during switching.

- Signal Transparency:** The switch does not degrade or alter the fiber signal.
- Power Loss Behavior:** Switches typically maintain the last known position during power loss.
