

# Technical Standards for Construction Site Distribution Boxes

Construction site distribution boxes must be installed in dry, ventilated areas at a standard height of 1.5–1.8 meters, using fireproof materials, proper wiring, grounding, and protective devices to ensure safety and compliance. Ensure the box has an appropriate IP or NEMA rating for environmental protection, especially for outdoor or industrial use. Installation Height and Fixing The bottom edge of the distribution box should be 1.5–1.8 meters above the ground, adjustable for operational convenience but consistent across the site. The box must be firmly fixed using suitable mounting brackets or screws to prevent movement due to vibration or collision. Installation must be level and stable, with permissible vertical deviations of 1.5 mm for boxes under 50 cm and 3 mm for taller boxes. Wiring and Electrical Safety Power must be turned off during wiring to ensure safety. Use high-temperature resistant copper wires with cross-sectional areas matching load requirements. Wiring should be neat, properly insulated, and clearly labeled, avoiding exposed copper or...
