- Inspect Wiring and Connections** Examine all wiring for loose terminals, damaged insulation, or improper connections. Tighten any loose screws and ensure wires are correctly inserted into DIN terminals.
- Measure Voltage** Use a voltmeter to check voltage at the power supply and at the distribution box. A significant voltage drop may indicate undersized wiring or long cable runs, which can trigger the red light.
- Restart the System** Power down the distribution box and any connected control units, then restart. Some systems reset the red light after a full power cycle.
- Check for Overloads** Unplug or turn off devices on the affected circuits and reintroduce the...
