- Multimode (OM1/OM2/OM3/OM4/OM5):** Core 50-62.5 μm , used for short-distance intra-data center links (up to 500 m). Commonly paired with LC, SC, or MPO connectors.

Applications

- Intra-rack connections:** Server NIC to top-of-rack switch, usually LC duplex or MPO breakout.
- Inter-rack connections:** Horizontal patching between distribution frames and spine switches, often LC or MPO.
- FTTH/building entry:** Indoor-outdoor transition cables connecting outside plant to customer premises, typically SC or LC.
- Test and measurement:** Connecting OTDRs, power meters, and light sources to active links, using LC, SC, or...
