Ladder trays are preferred for vertical installations because their rungs provide secure anchoring points to maintain cable positions and prevent sagging. Practical Implications Cable Support: Vertical runs require trays that can handle the weight of cables without deformation. Trough trays may need additional brackets or supports if used vertically. Heat Dissipation: Trough trays provide limited ventilation compared to ladder trays, which can be a concern if vertical runs carry power cables generating heat. Maintenance and Safety: Ladder trays allow easier cable access and tie-downs in vertical runs, reducing the risk of cable damage or misalignment.
