- OM2:** 50/125 μm core, orange jacket, supports 1 Gbps up to ~ 600 m at 850 nm.
- OM3:** 50/125 μm core, aqua jacket, laser-optimized for 10 Gbps up to 300 m at 850 nm.
- OM4:** 50/125 μm core, aqua jacket, enhanced laser-optimized for 10–40 Gbps up to 400 m at 850 nm.
- OM5:** 50/125 μm core, lime green jacket, supports wideband multimode transmission for 40–100 Gbps over short distances, optimized for multiple wavelengths.

- Connector Types:** SC, LC, FC, ST, MPO, MU, MT-RJ, and E2000 are common, affecting compatibility and density in racks.
- Simplex vs. Duplex:** Simplex cords have a single fiber, while duplex cords have two fibers for bidirectional communication.
- Bend-Insensitive Fiber:** G.657A1/A2 fibers are designed for tight spaces and FTTH applications, reducing signal loss from bending.
