Material and Shrink Considerations Fiber optic heat shrink tubing is usually made from cross-linked polyolefin with a hot fusion inner layer and may include a stainless steel or quartz rod for structural support during shrinkage. The tubing is supplied in an expanded form and shrinks when heated, typically using a hot air gun for thin-wall tubing or a propane/butane torch for heavy-duty tubing. The tubing should be cut slightly longer than the required coverage to account for longitudinal shrinkage, ensuring complete protection of the fiber splice. Installation Guidelines Tube sizing: Select tubing at least 10% larger than the cable diameter before shrinkage to ensure proper fit and wall thickness. Cutting: Use a sharp knife or suitable cutting tool to achieve clean, burr-free edges to prevent splitting during shrinkage. Shrink ratio: Most fiber optic heat shrink tubes have a 3:1 shrink ratio, meaning they can shrink to one-third of their expanded diameter, providing a snug fit over the fiber and rod assembly.
