Traditional internet services rely on copper cables that transmit electrical signals. In contrast, fiber. Any standard router, including the primary unit of a mesh Wi-Fi system, will work at its full potential with any standard Internet broadband terminal. Many people have used cable or DSL internet in the past, so they are used to having a modem.
