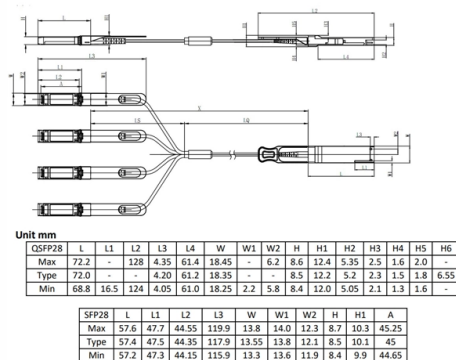

ITC cables are commonly used in PLCs, DCS systems, transmitters, and other instrumentation applications. Some ITC-ER versions also allow short exposed runs similar to TC-ER cables.
