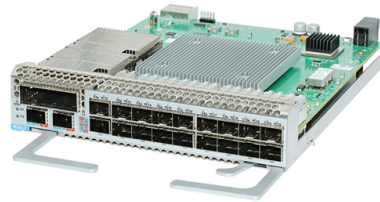


Why did the router lose fiber optic cable

Similarly, the Ethernet cable linking the ONT to the router should be high-quality (Cat6a or higher) and properly seated.
4. **Hardware or Firmware Issues** Routers or ONTs with outdated firmware may fail to negotiate a connection. Restarting devices, updating firmware, or testing with a different router can help identify hardware-related problems.
5. **ISP or Service Activation Problems** Sometimes the issue is on the ISP's end. If the ONT is active but your devices cannot access the internet, the ISP may need to activate your service or verify your account settings.

- Verify ONT Installation:** Ensure the fiber cable is connected to the ONT and the ONT is powered on. Wait for the status lights to stabilize.
- Check Router Connection:** Connect the router's WAN port to the ONT using a high-quality Ethernet cable.
- Configure Router Settings:** Enter the correct IP type (static or dynamic) and ISP credentials in the router's admin panel.
